

Jesmond Joggers 20th Anniversary Relay Race

Terms and Conditions 2026

Each runner must agree to the below terms & conditions in order to be able to participate within a relay team:

1. The race is organised Jesmond Joggers Running Club under UKA rules (UKA Road Race Licence #31204).
2. Each runner accepts that the organisers of the Jesmond Joggers Relay Race will take due care to reduce the risk of any loss, damage, claim, costs or expenses which may arise in consequence of their participation in this event, but that each runner is individually responsible for their own health and welfare.
3. Baggage and personal effects may be left on the bowling green at Race HQ at the owner's risk. We cannot guarantee that members of the race organiser's team will be at Race HQ at all times and there is no official manned storage baggage area.
4. Runners must not participate in the race if they are not in good health and will compete at their own risk.
5. Runners agree to have personal details (name, gender, age category, medical information) stored on a computer for entry processing. This information is not shared beyond the organising committee other than the race medical services provider Salus.
6. We regret that all entry fees are non-refundable if the race is cancelled. If the race is postponed to an alternative date all entries will be transferred over.
7. Runners must be 18 years or over on 14/07/2026.
8. On race day participants must follow all instructions given from the event organisers, volunteers/marshals, event officials, police, fire and ambulance / Salus medical services throughout the duration of the event.
9. Failure to follow event rules / event official's instruction may result in disqualification, loss of prize money and removal from official results.
10. Team declarations must be made by Friday 10 July 2026. Team changes can be made up until 18:30 on race day but must either be emailed to jjrelayrace@gmail.com or informed at Race HQ to ensure correct processing.
11. Race numbers must only be worn by runners declared in team entries. Any swapping of numbers will result in disqualification for the runners involved.
12. Race numbers will be available to collect by a single nominated club member from Race HQ (Paddy Freeman's Bowling Pavilion, High Heaton, NE2 2EY / What3Words ///

broke.early.those) from approximately 17:30 on Tuesday 14 July 2026. No numbers will be posted out.

13. Runners must compete wearing their registered club colours.
14. Race numbers must be worn on the front of the running vest or t-shirt and must not be cut, folded or altered in any way.
15. All runners must have looked at the course route and risks in advance and be present at the race briefing 10 minutes before the start time. Any delays will be communicated using the PA system.
16. It is not permitted to run with dogs, buggy, pushchairs or similar items (UKA rule TR55 S6 and S7).
17. The wearing of in-ear or over-ear headphones is strictly prohibited (UKA rule TR55 S5).
18. Team prizes will be awarded to the first three club teams. Each club can win more than one team prize.
19. Individual prizes will be awarded to the runners with the fastest legs in the following categories: senior male/open, senior female, V35 male/open and V35 female.
